ORDER:

Felspar, 15. Fireclay, 16. Fuschite quartzite, 17. Gypsum, 18. Jasper, 19. Kaolin, 20. Laterite, 21. Limekankar, 22. Mica, 23. Ochre, 24. Pyrophyllite, 25. Quartz, 26. Quartzite, 27. Sand (others), 28. Shale, 29. Silica Sand, 30. Slate, 31. Steatite or Talc or Soap stone.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Mines & Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1966 issued in G.O.Ms.No.1172, Industries and Commerce (M.I) Department, dated. 04.09.1967 and subsequently amended issued in the reference 3rd read above, from time to time.
