ORDER :

In the reference 1st read above, the Vice Chairman & Managing Director, M/s A.P Mineral Development Corporation Limited (APMDC) has requested the Director of Mines and Geology, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad to recommend their request to the Government for reserving the area of 95 Acres (38.445 Hect) for low grade Limestone (Minor) mineral, bearing Sy.No. 690,691 & 692 of Konanki (V), Piduguralla (M), Guntur District in their favour, under Rule 9-A (1) of APMMC Rules, 1966.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, the Director of Mines and Geology, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has stated that the Assistant Director of Mines and Geology, Dachepalli reported that the representative samples collected from the subject area have been chemically analysed and the report revealed that the mineral available is low grade Limestone which is used as Mosaic chips/Poultry grit. The report reveals that Ca as CaO ranges from 38% to 40% and Silica as SiO₂ ranges from 20.61% to 26.43%. Whereas, the Threshold Value of Cement grade Limestone is minimum of 35% of Ca as CaO and maximum of 18% of Silica as SiO₂ (IBM Circular No.T-45031/CGBM/2007(PF), dt.16.10.2009). But, according to the analysis report Silica as SiO₂ is above 20% and as such the mineral is not useful as Cement grade Limestone though Ca as CaO is within the limits.

3. The Director of Mines and Geology, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has further stated that the Limestone is listed at S.No.4 of schedule -1 to Rule 10 of Andhra Pradesh Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1966 and the rate of Seig. Fee per MT is fixed on par with the rate of royalty applicable to Limestone (Major). The prevailing rate of royalty for Limestone (Major) is Rs. 80/- per MT.

4. The Director of Mines and Geology, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has therefore requested the Government to consider the request of M/s. APMDC Ltd., for reserving of 95 Acres of land in Sy.No.690, 691 & 692 of Konanki (V), Piduguralla (M), Guntur District for Limestone (Minor), in favour of APMDC for industrial use, under Rule 9-A(1) of APMMC Rules 1966.

5. After careful consideration of the matter, the Government hereby decided to reserve the area in an extent of 95 Acres (38.445 Hect) in Sy.No. 690,691 & 692 of Konanki (V), Piduguralla (M), Guntur District in favour of M/s A.P Mineral Development Corporation Limited (APMDC), for low grade Limestone (Minor) mineral for industrial use, under Rule 9-A (1) of APMMC Rules, 1966.
